UA Early College Tuition and Payment Policies

Tuition Update

We are excited to announce that beginning in the Fall 2025 semester, The University of Alabama Early College will introduce a new dual enrollment tuition rate of \$33 per credit hour. Additionally, our first course, UAEC 200 College Readiness, which is mandatory for all students before enrolling in full UA courses, will continue to be offered at no cost! This new rate will apply to in-state and out-of-state students.

UA Early College Tuition and Payment Policies

- The student is the responsible party for payment (or payment arrangements) by deadline dates
- A UA Financial Authorized User (Guest Account) where parents may receive courtesy notices regarding their student's account
- Confirmed Schedule – A tuition balance has been paid
- Unconfirmed Schedule – A balance remains on the student account



If parents wish to set up a Financial Authorized User account, they will click the Student Financial Account Authorized User link, where the arrow is pointing on the homepage screenshot below. Once clicked, parents will be able to set up a guest account so they can receive courtesy notices related to tuition and other fees. This portal will allow parents to access their student's myBama account and take care of any financial payments required.

Bills:
Bills are available and due before noon, October 11th. All prior term bills are now due in full.

If your schedule is not secure for the semester, meal plans and other privileges will not activate until your payment arrangements have been completed and your schedule is subject to cancellation.

If you are setting up a new payment account, there is a minimum 3 business day waiting period required for each new account that must be verified. An account only has to be verified once.

UA Early College Parent Tips
